

## **AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS**

### **AAPEX DRIVING ACADEMY AWARD**

Awarded to a deserving graduate who is successful in the Transportation Technology Program at E. L. Crossley Secondary School. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **BRYNIAK FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded by the Bryniak family to a student who is proceeding to post-secondary studies in the Health Science field. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **CENTURY 21 TODAY REALTY LTD. FONTHILL/WELLAND SALES STAFF SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a deserving graduate of E. L. Crossley Secondary School who is continuing their education at university or college. **By application only.**

### **CFUW-WELLAND & DISTRICT SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a deserving graduating female student who is proceeding to university studies in Canada, on the basis of conscientious effort, and responsible contribution to the life of the school and who has at least a B+ average, and would benefit from financial assistance. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **CINEFEST NIAGARA**

Awarded to a graduating student who has demonstrated an interest in the Arts; visual, music, theatre or dance. Recommended by the Arts Department.

### **COMPASS GROUP, CANADA (CHARTWELLS)**

Awarded by Compass Group, Canada, operators of our cafeteria, to a deserving graduate who has contributed to school life. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **CYCLONE AWARD**

This award, generated by proceeds from a past student store, is presented to a student enrolled in a business program at a community college or university. It recognizes academic achievement and participation in extra-curricular activities. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **DAVID RINKER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a deserving graduate who plans to continue to further his/her music "education". Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **DE LA MATER SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded annually from the estate of Miss Magdelene De La Mater, former teacher of English and Languages at Pelham District High School, to the student proceeding to university studies who excels in these subjects and displays qualities of character, leadership and potential contribution to society. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **DEAN ELLIS EMERSON MEMORIAL AWARD**

Donated by family and friends in loving memory of Dean Ellis Emerson, a Crossley graduate, class of '92. Presented annually to one male graduate and one female graduate exhibiting determination, self-motivation, school spirit, interest in others and a positive attitude with students and staff. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

## **DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD OF NIAGARA - EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION AWARD**

Presented to the student who best exhibits excellence in school citizenship, leadership and participation, academic achievement and community involvement. Chosen by the Staff at E.L. Crossley Secondary School.

## **DR. JOSEPH E. DOWD SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded by the Dowd family in memory of a long time Fenwick physician Dr. Joseph E. Dowd, to a graduating student who has high standing in Calculus and two Sciences and who has shown a humanitarian concern for others. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

## **DSBN EXCELLENCE IN TECHNOLOGICAL EDUCATION AWARD**

This DSBN Excellence in Technological Education Award is presented to a student who has distinguished themselves in one of DSBN's Technological Education Programs.

## **DSBN STUDENT SUCCESS AWARD**

Awarded to a deserving graduate who is proceeding to the workplace, and who displaces a strong work ethic, employability skills and good citizenship. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

## **E. L. CROSSLEY ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded in memory of those who have gone before us, to a graduating student proceeding to post-secondary studies. The student shall be the child/grandchild of a person who attended or worked at Crossley. Participation in school activities is one of the qualifying requirements. **By application only.**

## **E. L. CROSSLEY AWARDS**

Awarded to deserving students who have made a contribution to school life. Chosen by the Principal.

## **E. L. CROSSLEY FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP IN ENGLISH AND HISTORY**

Awarded to a graduating student with first class honours in English and History, provided that he/she proceeds to further study at an institute of higher learning. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

## **E. L. CROSSLEY STAFF MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

In memory of teachers who have passed on, this award is given for academic performance and significant contributions to school life. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

## **E. L. CROSSLEY STUDENT COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a student who has demonstrated school spirit by his/her attendance at Students' Council organized events and has shown potential leadership by his/her actions. Voted by the Students' Council.

## **EDUCATION FOUNDATION OF NIAGARA (EFN) STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT AWARD**

Awarded to a graduating student who will be attending college, apprenticeship, or post high school certification programme, who has demonstrated good citizenship to their school and community. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **ELIZABETH ANNE THOMPSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded in memory of "Liz", a former student, to a graduate proceeding to post-secondary studies in Education (preferably Primary) or Theology. The recipient will have demonstrated academic achievement and humanitarian concern for others. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **FACE BEHIND THE MURAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a student who has attended E.L. Crossley for at least three years and is proceeding to post-secondary education. The student must have participated in extra-curricular activities, and cannot be the recipient of another major award. Chosen by the Students' Council.

### **FAITH REBEKAH LODGE AWARD**

Awarded to a graduating female student who has shown sincerity of effort and outstanding aptitudes in the field of Family Studies. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **FENWICK FIREFIGHTERS ASSOCIATION AWARD**

Awarded to a deserving graduate who is pursuing post-secondary education in any emergency services. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **FENWICK LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded by the Fabulous Fenwick Lions, in memory of Meryl Berry, to a graduating male student proceeding to post-secondary studies in the sciences. High achievement in the Sciences and contribution to the school are the requirements. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **FONTHILL AND DISTRICT KINSMEN CLUB SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a student who shows leadership in band, student council, or athletics or who makes an outstanding contribution to community service. The recipient must have a 75% average in his/her final year, must have attended Crossley for at least two years. **By application only.**

### **FONTHILL LIONS CLUB AWARD**

Awarded to a graduating male who, on the basis of diligence and sincerity of effort, has elected to pursue one of the trades. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **FONTHILL-SINGER'S CORNERS WOMEN'S INSTITUTE AWARD**

Awarded to a graduating student for sincerity of effort, who is pursuing further education in the field of Family Studies, Horticulture or Agriculture at a recognized college or university in the future. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **FONTHILL SOBEY'S AWARD**

Awarded to one female and male graduate who is planning to work or study and has shown a positive contribution to the community. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **GEORGE T. BOSMA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a deserving student who is proceeding to university. The scholarship recipient shall display the character of our friend George. This is an individual with a strong work ethic who has succeeded in the face of adversity through perseverance. The recipient shall be a community minded individual who displays strong school spirit and a person who takes pride in achieving his/her academic goals. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **GOVERNOR GENERAL'S ACADEMIC MEDAL**

A Bronze medal is awarded to the student who achieves the highest average upon graduation from a secondary school. The average includes all grade 11 and grade 12 courses as listed on the student's official transcript regardless of the stream or the subjects chosen. All students are eligible for consideration upon graduation.

### **HARLAND YOUNG MEMORIAL AWARD**

Awarded to a grade 12 student who has demonstrated a strong work ethic and determination. The successful candidate will be proceeding to either college, an apprenticeship or the world of work and must not have received any other major scholarship. Outstanding volunteerism has also been demonstrated. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **JODY STORTZ MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to the graduating student who has most benefitted in career direction after having had a co-operative education experience. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **JOSTEN'S GRADUATING ATHLETES OF THE YEAR AWARD**

Awarded to the graduating male and female athletes of the year.

### **JOYCE EMERSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to the E. L. Crossley student who received high first class honours in French, and who will pursue a course in an institute of higher learning. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **KAREN MOFFATT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Donated by friends in memory of Karen Moffatt, a former student at E. L. Crossley Secondary School. The scholarship is awarded to a student who is proceeding to post-secondary studies and who has contributed to the extra-curricular life of the school. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **LAING SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a graduating student on the basis of general proficiency in academic achievements, particularly in Chemistry, and for contribution to the extra-curricular life of the school. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **LARRY E. GAGNÉ MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded annually to graduating students who will, preferably, be pursuing post-secondary studies in French. **By application only.**

### **LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR'S COMMUNITY VOLUNTEER AWARD**

Demonstrating outstanding volunteerism. Chosen by Scholarship Committee.

### **LIFETIME VISION CENTRE SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded annually to a graduate of E. L. Crossley Secondary School interested in pursuing a career in the field of Science. **By application only.**

### **LOUIS S. & EDITH B. HANEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to four students who, in the opinion of the majority of teachers of the school have excelled in academic, scholastic, or other school activities, and who plan to attend an institute of higher learning. They must not have received, nor are eligible to receive any major scholarship. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **MAPLEVIEW CHARITIES EDUCATION**

To deserving graduates proceeding to post-secondary education who were always striving to improve their lives and have contributed to the greater community. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **MARILEE'S AWARD**

Awarded to a deserving female graduate who is planning to study fashion or related business and has shown a commitment to her classmates. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **NIAGARA PENINSULA AMATEUR RADIO CLUB TECH ACHIEVEMENT AWARD**

Awarded to a graduating E.L. Crossley student proceeding to post-secondary studies or apprenticeship in a technical field. The recipient should demonstrate interest in radio communications or the electronic or electrical fields. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **NIAGARA PENINSULA ENERGY STUDENT AWARD**

Awarded to a student that has accepted and entering in a field of study that is in line with Niagara Peninsula Inc. business at college or university. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **ONTARIO POWER AUTHORITY AWARD**

Awarded to a graduate who has completed and hence earned the Red Seal for the Energy SHSM. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **ONTARIO PRINCIPALS' COUNCIL STUDENT RECOGNITION AWARD**

Awarded to a student who makes a positive contribution to the school. Chosen by the Principal.

### **OSSTF DISTRICT 22 BURSARY**

To assist a deserving student from each secondary school in District 22. The candidate will have demonstrated responsibility within the school, community, and workplace. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **PELHAM ART FESTIVAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a student who is proceeding to post-secondary studies and has displayed proficiency in art. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **PELHAM HIGH ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP**

The scholarship will be awarded annually to a student who has demonstrated an ability to maintain a minimum grade average of 75% while participating in inter-school athletics and other clubs and has thereby contributed to the overall school function and received a well-rounded education. **By application only.**

### **PELHAM HORTICULTURE SOCIETY SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a graduate who is going to study horticulture. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **PELHAM PANTHERS BASKETBALL SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a student athlete who has been a positive role model and good all around student. Preference will be given to a student who has been in the Panthers organization at some point during their high school years. Recommended by the Phys Ed Department.

### **PELHAM REFERRAL GROUP SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to the student who shows an entrepreneurial aptitude and wants to explore business in post secondary education. **By application only.**

### **PHOENIX MASONIC LODGE BURSARY**

Awarded by the members of Phoenix Lodge, Fonthill, to a deserving student who is proceeding to post-secondary studies and has not received another award. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **PORT COLBORNE-WAINFLEET CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AWARD**

Awarded to a Wainfleet graduate for outstanding contribution to school and community, academic achievement in the business stream and furthering his/her education in business. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **PROM COMMITTEE SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a graduate who has a minimum B+ average, held a part-time job throughout grade 12, been involved in school activities and proceeding to post-secondary studies. The student should be looked on as friendly, respected and an active member of E. L. Crossley. Chosen by the Prom Committee.

### **R. V. HOWARD SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to the graduate of E. L. Crossley Secondary School who has the highest standing in Mathematics in Years 3 and 4.

### **ROTARY CLUB OF FONTHILL MEDALISTS AND SCHOLARSHIPS**

Awarded to two graduating interact members on the basis of excellent moral character, participation in school activities, and contribution to school life. The recipients should have those characteristics, abilities and interests which personify the Rotary motto – "Service above Self". **By application only.**

### **ROYAL CANADIAN LEGION SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded by the Talbot Trail Branch 613, Fonthill, to a graduating student proceeding to post-secondary studies. The student should have contributed to school life and preference is given to the child/grandchild of a Branch 613 member. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **RUTH YOUNG MEMORIAL AWARD**

Awarded to a grade 12 student who is planning to further their education and career in the field of **Social Sciences** and who has demonstrated outstanding volunteerism. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **SHSM SCHOLARSHIP**

The DSBN Specialist High Skills Major Award is presented to a graduating student who completed all the requirements of the SHSM program and will be receiving an OSSD with an SHSM red seal. This SHSM student will have demonstrated outstanding achievement in their SHSM program according to their teachers and cooperative education employers. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **THE VOICE ANNIVERSARY SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a graduating E. L. Crossley student proceeding to college or university and studying media (print or broadcast) or a related field, who has maintained a minimum B average in his/her graduating year, and has some involvement in the school or community beyond the required 40 hrs. of volunteer service. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **TOWN OF PELHAM SCHOLARSHIP (A)**

Awarded upon the recommendation of the Mathematics Department to an outstanding student who is proceeding to university. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **TOWN OF PELHAM SCHOLARSHIP (B)**

Awarded to a graduating student who has contributed to the affairs and life of the school while maintaining scholarly excellence and who plans to study in the field of Health Sciences. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

### **TOWNSHIP OF WAINFLEET SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to the graduating student from Wainfleet who has achieved the highest overall average.

### **VALERIE CASTER HEALTH SCIENCE AWARD**

Awarded to a graduating student who has contributed significantly to the extra-curricular life of Crossley and/or their communities and who have maintained academic excellence. This student plans to study in the field of Health Sciences at either college or university. Preference will be given to Wainfleet residents, but others are also encouraged to apply. **By application only.**

### **VALERIE CASTER TECHNOLOGY AWARD**

Awarded to a graduating student who has shown an aptitude in a technology class while at Crossley, and who has chosen to pursue a post secondary program in one of the following areas: engineering, technology or the trades. Preference will be given to Wainfleet residents, but others are also encouraged to apply. **By application only.**

### **WAINFLEET HISTORICAL SOCIETY AWARD**

Awarded to a deserving graduate pursuing post-secondary studies in History. Must be a resident of Wainfleet. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

**WAINFLEET LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a graduating student who has distinguished herself/himself both in scholarship and contribution to the life of the school. Recipient must be a Wainfleet resident. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

**WELLAND TRIBUNE BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a graduating student proceeding to post secondary school. **By application only.**

**WILLIAM AND MARTHA McMILLAN SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a graduate who is proceeding to post-secondary education in Canada, who has maintained a high academic standing throughout secondary school and who has, in the opinion of the teaching staff, contributed significantly to extra-curricular activities. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.

**WILLIAM J. ALSOP MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded by the Alsop family in memory of Bill Alsop, a strong supporter of our students and community involvement. The recipient shall be proceeding to post-secondary education and have been involved in extra-curricular activities. Chosen by the Scholarship Committee.
