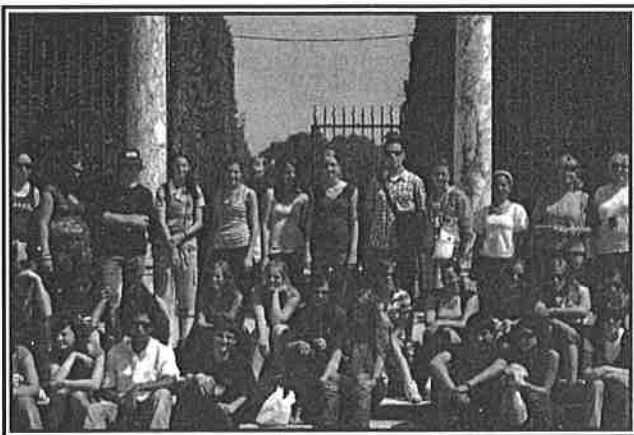


TENTATIVE ITINERARY 2012

- JULY 4 Depart TORONTO from Pearson International Airport
- JULY 5 Arrive PARIS in early morning and transfer by motor coach to our student residence: Maison des Étudiants Canadiens.
- JULY 5-26 Classes, study tours (Versailles, Giverny, (Monet) Loire Valley, Rouen, Dieppe), student exploration/appreciation of Paris including a Seine Cruise, museum visits, Eiffel Tower and Montmartre.
- JULY 14 Bastille Day - special events planned for this day.
- JULY 27 Transfer to PARIS' Charles de Gaulle Airport for flight to Toronto's Pearson International Airport arriving in the afternoon.

NOTE:

1. Daily schedules will vary with some days devoted to morning and afternoon classes and other days full day study tours. Students are expected to allocate a portion of their daily time to homework/study/ CPT preparation.
2. All students will complete a CPT - Culminating Performance Task.
3. All study tours are part of the instructional program for course credit.
4. Afternoons/evenings will be a combination of scheduled and free-time activities including designated study time.
5. Students may be expected to complete some course work prior to departure.

OUR PROGRAM
